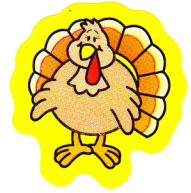

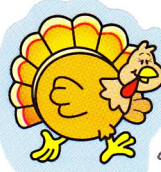

be and why?



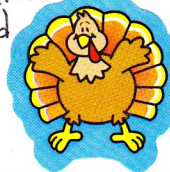
Turkey Task!

is better & why?



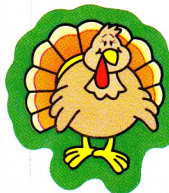
Turkey Task!

grateful for to God!



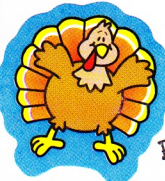

God?



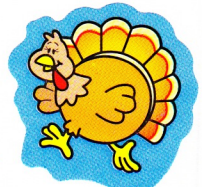
Turkey Task!

drumsticks!" 😊



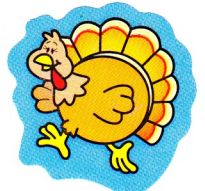
Turkey Talk!

are called Hens.



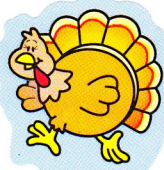

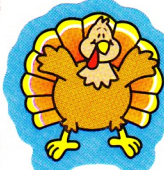
Turkey Task!

In 15 seconds, list all the people you are grateful for in your life.



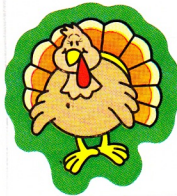
Turkey Talk!

Which do you appreciate most: sight, sound, taste, touch or smell? Why?



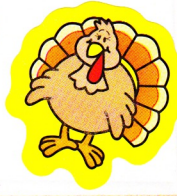
Turkey Task!

What is something in nature that you are thankful for?



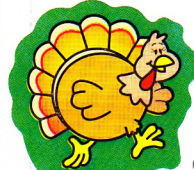
Turkey Task!

Who could you call and give thanks to right now? Do it!



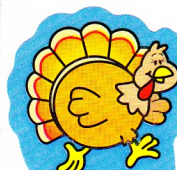
Turkey Talk!

Make a card of thanks for the mailman & stick it in your mailbox.



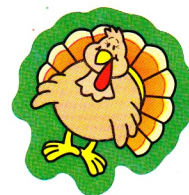
Turkey Talk!

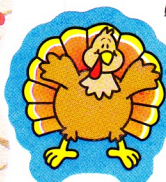
Turkey Task !

Make a thank you card for someone & then hide it somewhere where they'll find it!



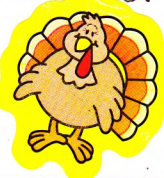
Turkey Talk !

Read 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18. When does God tell us to be thankful? Is it ever hard to be thankful?



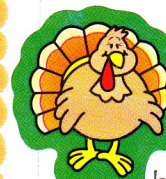
Turkey Task !

Read Colossians 3:15-17. Make up a song about being thankful to the Lord!



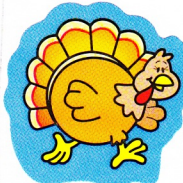
Turkey Task !
